**Alain Allard** of Quebec, Canada, is not only an excellent trainer and successful competitor, he's an outstanding teacher who can articulate riding and training concepts so they are easily understood. He can both "do" and teach.

An NRHA Futurity winner with Brennass Kid (now a prominent sire of reining winners), Allard also is a many times NRHA futurity finalist, winner of the NRHA Open at Congress and reserve in the Superstakes. Seven years in a row Allard was Quebec trainer of the year, many times Quebec futurity winner and member of the Quebec Hall of Fame. His lifetime NRHA earnings are \$199,314.

He is an NRHA-approved judge, an AQHA reining judge and has judged all the major reining events in the United States, Canada and Europe. He sat on the NRHA board of directors for 10 years.

Allard's breeding program produced three finalists at the

1996 NRHA Futurity out of his six broodmares: Mr. Tori Kid ridden by Tim McQuay, She's Rugged Kid ridden by Brent Wright and The Great Kid ridden by Allard.

He graduated an equine technologist from ITA La Pocatiere in Quebec and then taught there for six years. He has been training horses since 1980.

**Clinic Fee:** \$200

Clinic fee covers two-hour sessions on Saturday and Sunday. The

**Illinois Horse Fair, presented by Purina Mills, Midway Trailer Sales and John Deere, is in its 20th year and annually attracts more than 10,000 horse people.**

limited clinic will be for up to 12 riders in a group session, with each rider working individually. Clinic applicants must submit a short video or DVD that demonstrates their riding ability and their horse's training level.

Clinic fee includes one stall with first bedding, shared use of a tack stall, exhibitor badge for rider and one weekend pass to Horse Fair. Clinic horses will be stalled together.

Clinic sessions may be audited by Horse Fair pass holders (general admission: \$12 per day; \$20 weekend).

Each day, Allard will hold one-hour Question & Answer sessions for clinic riders and observers.

All horses must have a current negative Coggins. Out-of-state horses must have Health Certificate and Entry Permit number. Signed release forms are required from all participants.
